Lap Quilt
47"x 59"

MATERIALS

1 yd. TRO1230(Postcards/Center)
1 1/4 yd. TRO1231 (#4 Border Print)
1/4 yd. *each* of the following print fabrics.(Stars)

TRO1233-2
TRO1235-1
TRO1235-2
1/4 yd. *each* of the following background fabrics.(Stars)

TRO1235-3
TRO1236-1
TRO1236-2

1/2 yd. TRO1235-3(Inner and #3 Borders)
Batting

1/2 yd. TRO1235-2(Binding)

3 yd. TRO1234(Backing)

CUTTING AND PIECING INSTRUCTIONS

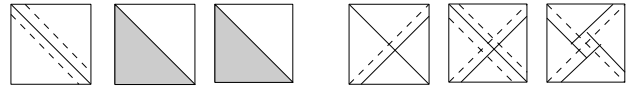
TRO1230
Cut a piece 34 1/2" lengthwise by 22 1/2" width wise. This is the center of the quilt.

TRO1235-3 - Inner Border and 3rd Border
Cut 8 - 1 1/2" w strips. (Inner Border strips) Sew these together into one long strip and cut into the following border lengths.
Cut 2 - 34 1/2" l. Sew these to the sides of the quilt top. Press the seams toward the border strips.
Cut 2 - 24 1/2" l. Sew these to the top and bottom of the quilt top. Press the seams toward the border strips.
Save the remaining strip for the 3 border.

STARS - 2nd Border
From each of the 8 - 1/4 yd. *print* fabrics cut as follows.
Cut 6 - 3 1/4" squares.
Cut 3 - 2 1/2" squares.

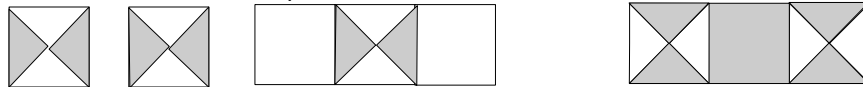
From each of the 5 - 1/4 yd. *background* fabrics cut as follows.
Cut 10 - 3 1/4" squares.
Cut 20 - 2 1/2" squares.

To assemble the star blocks pair up a background print with a print fabric.
For each star piece as follows.
Draw a diagonal line across the back of each of the 3 1/4" background squares.
Place the 3 1/4" print squares and background squares right sides together.
Stitch 1/4" from both sides of the drawn line. Cut on the drawn line. Press the seam toward the print side.



Place the half-square triangles right sides together so that the prints are on the background triangles. Draw a line diagonally across the previously sewn seam. Stitch 1/4" from both sides of the drawn line as before. Cut apart on the drawn line. Press the seams from the back in a circular direction.

You should now have 12 Hourglass blocks.

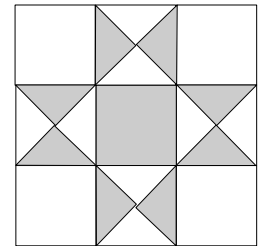


Sew a 2 1/2" background square onto each side of an Hourglass block. Press the seams toward the background squares.
Sew an Hourglass square onto each side of matching print square. Press the seams toward the print square.

Sew the three sections together. Press the seams all in the same direction.

Make 3 stars from *each* of the print fabrics with the exception of TRO1235-2. Make 4 from this fabric.

Using the 24 star blocks sew two rows of eight stars each. Press the seams open. Sew these to the sides of the quilt top. Press the seams toward the Inner border.
Sew two more rows of 6 star blocks each. Press the seams open.
Sew these to the top and bottom of the quilt top. Press the seams toward the Inner Border.



3rd Border(TRO1235-3)
Using the remaining 1 1/2" strip cut 2 - 48 1/2" l. Sew these to the sides of the quilt top. Press the seams toward these strips.
Cut 2 - 38 1/2" l. Sew these to the top and bottom of the quilt top. Press the seams toward these strips.

4th Border(TRO1231)
Cut 4 - 4 1/2" w Border strips centered on the large Holly leaves. Cut 2 strips 50 1/2" l. Sew these to the sides of the quilt top. Press the seams toward these strips. Cut 2 more 46 1/2" l. Sew these to the top and bottom of the quilt top. Press as before.

FINISHING

Piece backing fabric(TRO1234). Make sure you cut off the selvages and press the seams open.
Layer the backing, batting and quilt top. Baste the layers together. Quilt as desired.
Cut 6 - 2 1/2" w strips from TRO1235-2. Bind your quilt.
Enjoy!
